STUDENT CHECKLIST

Legally purchased sheet music

- iPads/tablet devices are recommended (for electronically purchased sheet music) as much as possible. This provides more ease with page turns.
- If using legal music in a bound score, be sure pages are set to stay open and page turns are set up well with minor folding to the corners of each page.
- If a page turner is needed, it must not be the student's applied teacher. Students need to secure their own page turner.
- Reminder--- singers will have **two minutes** to discuss music with the staff pianist just prior to singing (high school on Saturday).
- Music should be easy to read with nothing missing on the score.

Parking

- There is no special parking such as advanced payment.
- There is some on street parking but is short term.
- Parking decks that are available are the Cary St Deck and the Broad St Deck. Both are about 3 blocks away. \$2/hr. up to \$16 max for the day (8 hrs. or more).
- Nothing closer. All others are reserved lots and will be ticketed.

Honor Recitals

 If you receive first place in your category, you have the privilege of singing one song for the honor recitals later in the day. The song you choose must be 4 minutes* or less in length. Those singers will report to the registration area 15 minutes before the scheduled honors recitals.

*Judicious cuts in the music may be made for the honors recital only.
